teachings by Dr. David Jeremiah (whom I consider to be one of the most gifted and accurate Bible teachers of our day). Dr. Jeremiah had embarked on a study of the Book of Revelation from his pulpit at Shadow Mountain Community Church in San Diego, California. Now my original intent was to listen in on just one message, however, once I tasted I was addicted and proceeded to “binge my way” through his Revelation series archives.

My purpose in sharing this is not to re-preach or highlight any particular sermon that Dr. Jeremiah powerfully presented. The reason I share this is because this fresh look at the final book of the Bible served to refocus me upon the SOVEREIGNTY OF OUR LORD AND SAVIOR, THE MESSIAH, JESUS CHRIST, KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. I needed a refocus because nowadays it often seems as if evil is winning, as if right-

eousness is waning and as if the church is wanting. Revelation reminds me that it only “seems” that way. God has everything under total control and Christ and His Bride win in the end.

Perhaps you’ve been binging on your distorted version of a “Life Reality Show” resulting in fear, faithlessness and failure. Let me encourage you to partake of a Blessed Binge through the Book of Revelation. Just read it!!! Don’t worry about understanding it all, simply allow this wonderful Unveiling of Jesus Christ to course through your mind and soul. You will be reminded that pain is temporary, evil will be judged, God is Holy, righteousness will be rewarded, victory is guaranteed and heaven is forever. You will be re-ignited to proclaim to the world that “Jesus Christ Is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”
