“A Message from the Maasai”

I just returned from Kenya where three members of our church along with several other Southern Baptist “missionaries” convened to conduct leadership training for pastors and their wives in the city of Kiserian, very near Nairobi. These leaders were predominantly from the Maasai tribe, well known and respected as the warriors of Africa. Something that stood out so clearly for all of us was the fervor and passion with which these dear brothers and sisters in Christ served and celebrated our Lord. Their worship wasn’t westernized; it was African culture empowered by Heaven’s Holy Ghost.

One of the prominent traditions among the Maasai is for a team of young men to kill a lion together as a rite of passage from boyhood to manhood. The elders shared with us that the cohort of 10 teenagers train together for months in preparation for their lion hunt expedition and

become a band of brothers that will never be dismantled. Their mission is dangerous and daunting and success requires Courage, Trust and Coordination.

We don’t have to work very hard to grasp the application of this tradition as it relates to our mission to fulfill the great commission in Northeast Ohio. We are engaged in spiritual warfare as the “enemy of souls” seeks to steal, kill and destroy. It is only as we labor together (as believers and as churches) in Courage, Trust and Coordination that we win the battle against “*our adversary, the devil, who prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour*” (1 Peter 5:8). We need the tenacity of David as he submitted to King Saul his qualifications to fight Goliath; that he *rescued the sheep from the mouth of the lion*. (1 Samuel 17:35)

Let’s pray for the Holy Spirit to give the pastors and the people of our association the Courage, the Trust and the Coordination to work and pray together to win the battle in Jesus’ name. Together we can get it done.

They have a fascinating story of how God led Rev. Baumgardner and his family to move from Atlanta, Georgia to Bristolville, Ohio on January 1, 1968. The first worship service of Grace Baptist was on February 4, 1968 in Danceland. You'll need to attend Saturday's service if you would like to hear the rest of the story. Other guests include Rev. Bill Sprague who was the fourth pastor and served for 31 years. Singers and musicians who served in the church at one time have also been invited back to serve. Most of the guest's speaking and singing will take place on Saturday July 14 from 3pm - 5pm. We will be having a power point display of pictures, a reading of the history, speakers sharing their memories and singing.

Then on Sunday July 15 at 9:30am we will have a combined Sunday School to discuss the original church plant and other interesting points from our history. In our worship at 10:45 am we are planning on special music from Stella (Baumgardner) Stout, Stephens, Jr. and Josh Baumgardner. Then Steve will be bringing our morning message.
